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RICOH THETA SC2 360° CAMERA

1. BEFORE USE

-Check the unit and all accessories for damage and cleanliness, and report to Max or Circulation Staff if anything is amiss (a small card in the case will indicate the included components)

2. BASICS



-Download “Ricoh Theta” app

-Power camera on (a light will appear), press and hold the Wi-fi button. In your phone’s Wi-fi settings, connect to “THETAYP00153061.OSC” network. The password is “00153061” without the quotation marks. You may need to go to “Shooting” in the app and allow connection

-Switch between still images and video with the Mode button – the small black screen on the front of the device will indicate which is active

-Capture images or video with the front shutter button, which will chirp

- The Timer button will initiate a 5 second countdown, visible on the front display
- Review and delete captured media using the Ricoh Theta app. Media will otherwise be stored on your device's Camera Roll or Photos app

3. ADVANCED

- Using a tripod attached to the device's base allows you to record a stable, uninterrupted view of the area
- A series of recordings throughout a space helps create a 3D tour
- While connected to the "THETAYP00153061.OSC" network, you can connect via Bluetooth in the settings to capture (though not preview) recordings with the app
- When transferring long videos from the device to your smartphone, plug in the device to maintain battery
- Operation Manual is available for additional support – see Max or search for "Ricoh Theta SC2" online

4. WHEN FINISHED

- Transfer all recordings to your own devices, playing them back or reviewing them to ensure they sound and look correct
- Delete recordings from the device via the app
- Bring items and all accessories to the Circulation Desk for checking in
